-a master plan combining active waterfront uses with public recreational uses; special features along the Promenade include pergolas and seating at access points from neighboring streets, areas for fishing, marine bollards for mooring ships, and historic markers at Cadillac Landing commemorating the founding of the city

- **Indianapolis Waterfront- Capital City Landing, Indianapolis, IN**

-the centerpiece of this park is Celebration Plaza in which its green space is oriented to the river via a grass and stone amphitheatre that breaks through the existing floodwall; this new landscape supports developments on sites adjacent to the park and in it, such as an Imax theatre, the State of Indiana Museum, the NCAA Headquarters, a minor league baseball park, and additions to the Indianapolis Zoo

- **River Legacy Park, Arlington, TX**

-involved a master plan and the design of a 370-acre park along the Trinity River that provides zones for active sports such as baseball, soccer, and Basketball, as well as a playground and areas for picnics and other passive recreation; Includes wilderness zones to protect the fragile natural environment which consist of walking, jogging and bike trails, river overlooks and nature study areas
