TO BE ENTITLED:**

**A RESOLUTION TENTATIVELY LEVYING AN AD VALOREM
PROPERTY TAX FOR THE CITY OF PENSACOLA
INCLUDING THE DOWNTOWN IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT
FOR 2012; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
PENSACOLA, FLORIDA:**

SECTION 1. An ad valorem tax of 4.2895 mills is tentatively levied for 2012 against all property, both real and personal, not exempt from taxation within the corporate limits of the City of Pensacola.

SECTION 2. An ad valorem tax of 2.0000 mills is tentatively levied for 2012 against all property, both real and personal, not exempt from taxation within the limits of the City of Pensacola Downtown Improvement District.

SECTION 3. This constitutes a 1.565% decrease in the property tax levy.

SECTION 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the City Council.
