Dear Commissioner Robinson,

I am pleased to notify you that the Board of Directors of the National Fish and Wildlife Foundation has approved an award not to exceed Eleven Million Thirty Two Thousand Three Hundred Dollars (\$11,032,300) to Escambia County, Florida to fund the project entitled "Bayou Chico Restoration."

This notice of intent to award is conditioned on NFWF's receipt of a full and complete project proposal satisfactory in all respects to NFWF and the subsequent negotiation and execution of a NFWF project funding agreement. Please note it typically takes four (4) to eight (8) weeks to complete these steps following this notice of award, depending on how quickly Escambia County, Florida is able to respond to outstanding information needs.

Furthermore, NFWF's standard payment terms are thirty (30) days following the submission of an acceptable payment request in accordance with the governing funding agreement. As a result, please expect to receive a project payment no sooner than two (2) to three (3) months after receiving this notice of award. Escambia County, Florida may elect to expend funds on contemplated project costs prior to the execution of a funding agreement, but such expenditures will be at the sole risk of Escambia County, Florida and NFWF will not be liable for reimbursement of such expenditures until: (i) NFWF has received a full project proposal to its satisfaction; (ii) NFWF has executed a funding agreement for the project; and (iii) NFWF has received and approved a reimbursement request for such expenditures.

Finally, please note that NFWF may require additional information about the various components of the project, including but not limited to a reasonably detailed scope of work, schedule and budget for each, prior to contracting those components. We will work with you over the coming weeks to assemble this information and to establish a suitable contracting framework for the project and its components.

Amanda Green (Amanda.Green@nfwf.org) will be your primary contact at NFWF for the administration of this project and will be contacting you in the coming weeks with a funding draft agreement for your review.
